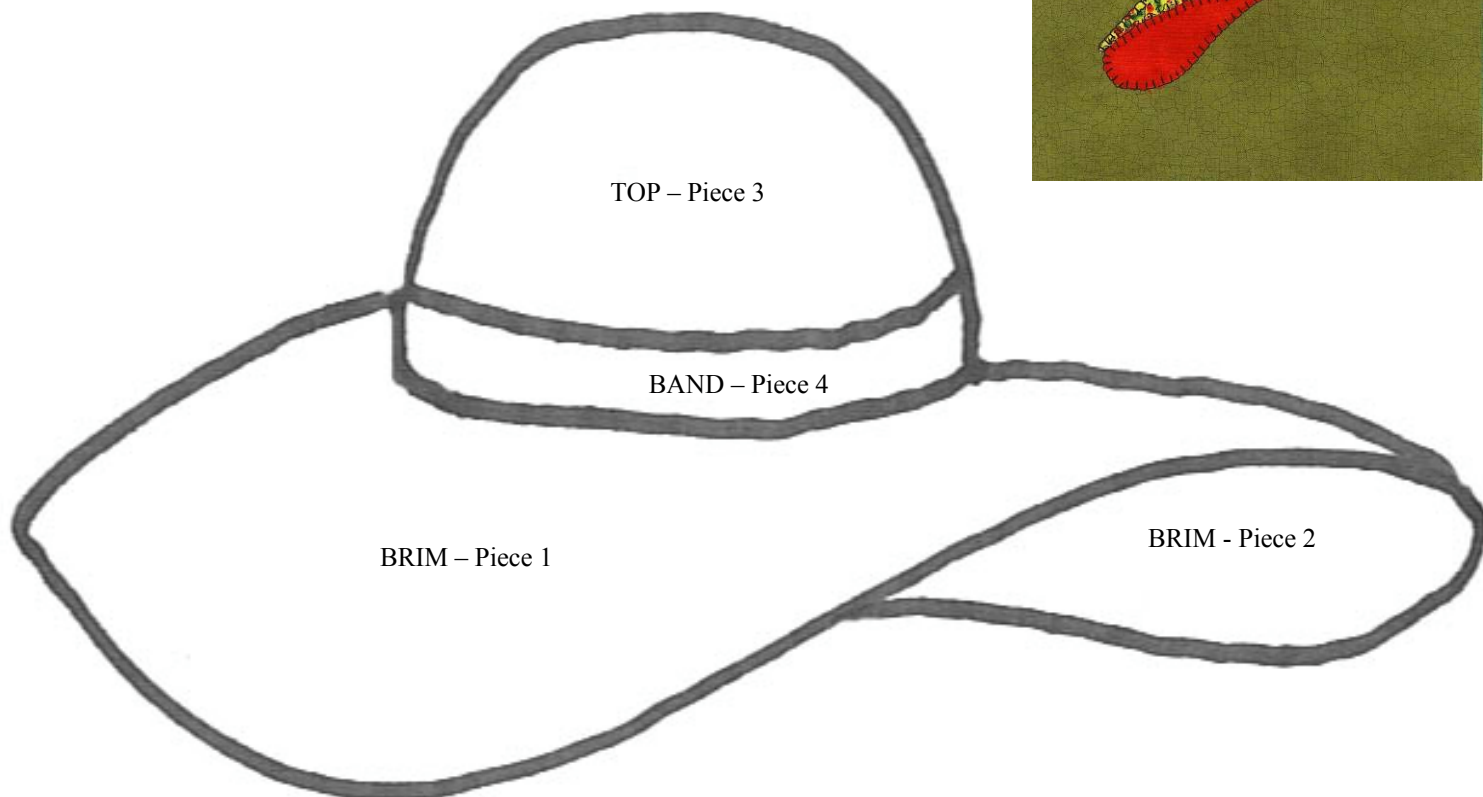
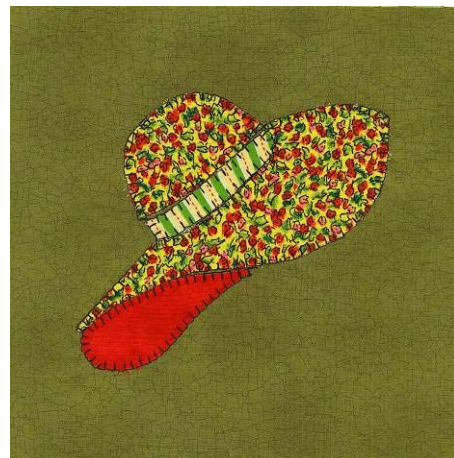

Cole's Hat



INSTRUCTIONS

- Cut an 8-1/2" square of 100% cotton fabric (any color) for the background. For the hat, use cottons, satins or whatever strikes your fancy. Trace the four pieces to make your patterns.
- The band may be a bright contrasting fabric, lace or other embellishment. You may use bows or ribbons or other embellishments.
- The brim of the hat is two pieces; piece one may be the same as the top fabric or something different; piece 2 can be a darker fabric for the shadowed underside of the brim.
- Arrange the pieces and pin in place. Stitch the shapes to the background, using your preferred method of appliqué, either by hand or machine.

Make as many blocks as you wish. Attach your name to each block twice; one stays with the block and one goes in the drawing basket. The more blocks you make, the better your chances are to win, but you may only win one set.
