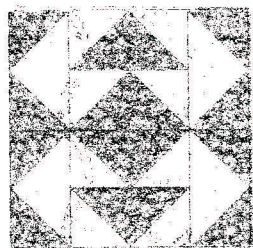




Block Party November, 2010



Mosaic 3 Block

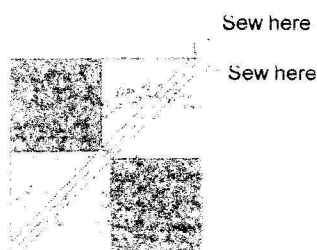
What you will need:

Scraps or fat eighth of a dark blue for color 1
Cut one 5 1/4" square and four 2 7/8" squares

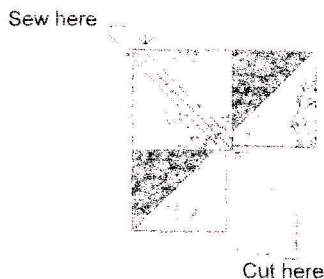
Scraps or fat eighth of a light blue for color 2
Cut one 5 1/4" square and four 2 7/8" squares

Directions:

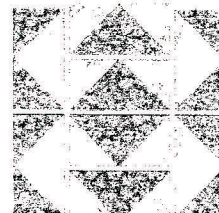
1. To speed piece the flying geese portion of this block to yield 4 flying geese units of each color combination, take your dark color 1 large (5 1/4") square and lay two light color 2 small (2 7/8") squares on top of it at the upper left and lower right corners with right sides together. Mark a diagonal line on the light color squares and sew 1/4" on either side of the line. (See diagram) Cut on the drawn diagonal line. Press the seams outward.



2. Now place your other small (2 7/8") square on the remaining corner of the large triangle on each of the pieces constructed in step 1. Mark the diagonal on each piece and sew on either side of the marked line, as in step 1. Cut apart on marked line. (See diagram)



3. Using the diagram below, sew the center flying geese vertical units together, then sew two of the other geese units together to end and repeat so that you have two units. Sew these on either side of the center vertical unit and you're done!
