

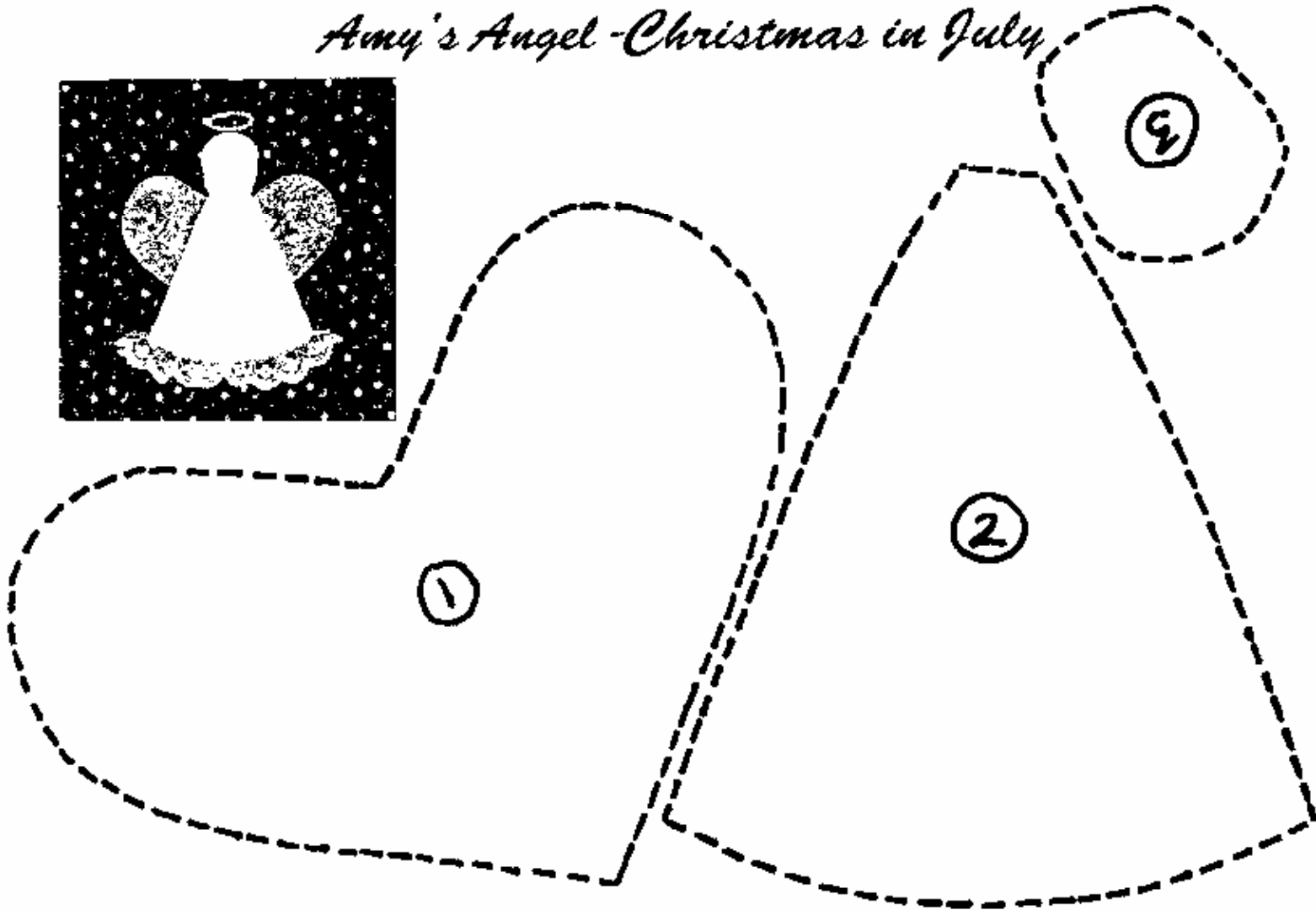


BLOCK PARTY

Amy's Angel - Christmas in July



INSTRUCTIONS

The background is an 8-1/2" square of dark Christmas fabric.

Cut the three angel pieces from your choices of white and gold shades of fabric. Use cottons, satins or anything that strikes your fancy.

- The heart shape will be the wings-lay that piece down on the background first.
- The triangular shape is the body lay that down next - (on top of the wings).
- The oval shape is the head. Lay that down last.

Arrange the pieces and pin in place. Stitch the shapes to the background, using your preferred method of applique (hand or machine).

OPTIONAL:

Embellish with lace, buttons, beads, and don't forget to add a halo!

Make as many blocks as you wish. Attach your name to each block twice. One stays with the block and one goes in the drawing bag. The more blocks you make, the more chances you have to win a set of blocks, but you may only win one set.
