

ULTIMATE GUILD CHALLENGE



HERE ARE THE LETTERIFIC SPECIFICS...

- You choose a letter of the alphabet and one object that corresponds with that letter.
- In a 30" x 30" space you will design, in collage style, a quilt showing off your chosen object.
- Repeat it.
- Fill the space with it.
- After your design is done add a 6" border on the TOP and the BOTTOM only and in that border use your chosen letter as a design element.
- You can repeat your letter as many times as you wish but it must appear at least once in each border.
- Now your finished quilt will measure 42" in length x 30" in width.

The hardest part, it seems, is knowing exactly what the collage style is. We do have a set of pictures we have put together to show what we are after. We want our final showing of quilts to be uniform so it is important that we are all after the same look. If you need to see the pictures give us a call and we will send them out to you or we will have them with us at the guild meeting so come see us.

Collage style means you would take your item, make it in several different colors, or sizes, or in parts and pieces, and then repeat these in a collection by overlapping the ONE item.

Please think one item and not a broad topic, category, feeling, or style. If a judge would walk up to your quilt we want them to immediately know what your letter represents.

We had two sets of alphabets letters to pass out. Many letters have already been chosen. If you have an idea and would like to participate we want to hear from you so we can assign you a letter. If for any reason you want to chat with us about this year's challenge we would love to hear from you.
