# Making Neonatal Quilts



- Fabrics used must be 100% cotton or 100% cotton flannel.
- Any pattern you choose is great!
- Quilts should not be smaller than 36" x 36" and no larger than 42" x 42." Note the change in size as incubators are now larger! Also, they do not need to be square.
- Quilts may be hand quilted, machine quilted or tied with some form of cotton thread, not yarn.
- Bindings may be traditionally attached, or you may use the "pillow case" method.
- No "raggy" style quilts as stray fibers are dangerous to tiny lungs.
