Hawaiian Appliquè Class:

We will be learning needle turn appliqué while learning about traditional Hawaiian design. Participants have the opportunity to design their own appliqué motif or trace one. If you took the snow dyeing class as well, we will be talking about how best to incorporate your beauty fabric into your one-of-a-kind Hawaiian design.

Supply List for Hawaiian Applique Class (needle turn applique):

One yard of fabric for background

One yard of fabric for appliqué piece (Kona is not recommended)

Fine thread: silk, bottom line or 60 weight or finer

In colors that blend or match

Freezer paper: at least two pieces that are 36"

Masking tape

Stapler

Roxanne's basting glue or equivalent or regular thread

Paper scissors

Fabric scissors; that can cut small detail

Iron and pressing pad

Needles; your favorite applique needles. I like 9 Between needles.

Regular pencil and chalk pencil or favorite marking pen/pencil.
