Ice Dyeing Fabric:

Dyeing fabric with snow/ice gives a wonderful watercolor type feeling to the visual texture. We will briefly talk about color mixing and color theory to build confidence in working with mixing dye. We will also spend time looking at how folding fabric ~~with~~^{will} create textures.

Supply List for Ice Dyeing Class:

- 4 to 5 yards of fabric (Fabric needs to be 100% cotton, prewashed without fabric softeners, prefer PFD fabric)
- A Colander, grate (cooling rack) or screening material and binder clips. (These things can not be used with food afterwards, the dollar stores are a great source. They should be at least 3 or 4 " deep, and rectangular shaped if possible).
- A bag of crushed ice or small cubes.
- A gallon of water.
- A roll of paper towel or rags.
- Wear painting type clothes or apron
- \$10 supply fee for gloves, dyes, auxiliary chemicals and tools.

* please wear layers of clothing for maximum comfort during class

* please avoid wearing perfume / strong smelling hair products because some students are sensitive to these odors

* Bring sack lunch (we have refrigerator/microwave to use) & something to drink or can go to nearby fast food restaurants on 28th St or 44th St.
