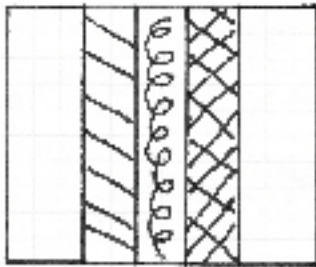
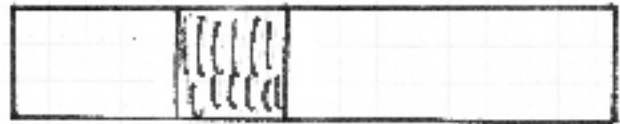


12 x 10 scrappy with sashing neonatal pattern

Cutting instructions

Cut scraps of fabric into six 3 1/2 in. squares.

Using scraps or 2 1/2 in. strips, cut 27 pieces measuring 2 1/2 x 10 1/2 inches.

Using white or another solid contrasting color (you will need approximately 30" of uncut fabric), cut 3 1/2 inch strips. From these strips, cut eighteen 3 1/2 in x 10 1/2 in. rectangles. Also cut four 3 1/2 in. x 9 1/2 in. rectangles, AND four 5 in. x 3 1/2 in rectangles.

Sewing Instructions

To form block, sew the 3 scrappy strips together. Make 9 of these strip sets. Add a white or other solid color 3 1/2 x 10 1/2 in. strip to each long side of the strip sets.

To form the sashing, sew a 5 x 3 1/2 inch rectangle to the left side of one of the 3 1/2 in. squares. Add a 3 1/2 x 9 1/2 in. rectangle to the right side of the square. Add another square to the right side, the another 3 1/2 x 9 1/2 in. rectangle, another square, then one more 5 x 3 1/2 n. rectangle. make 2 sashing strips.

Sew 3 blocks into a row. Add a sashing strip to the bottom, another row of blocks, another sashing strip, then the final row.
