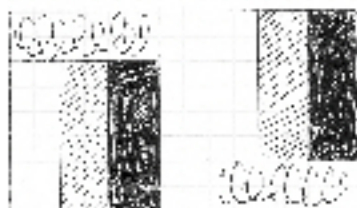
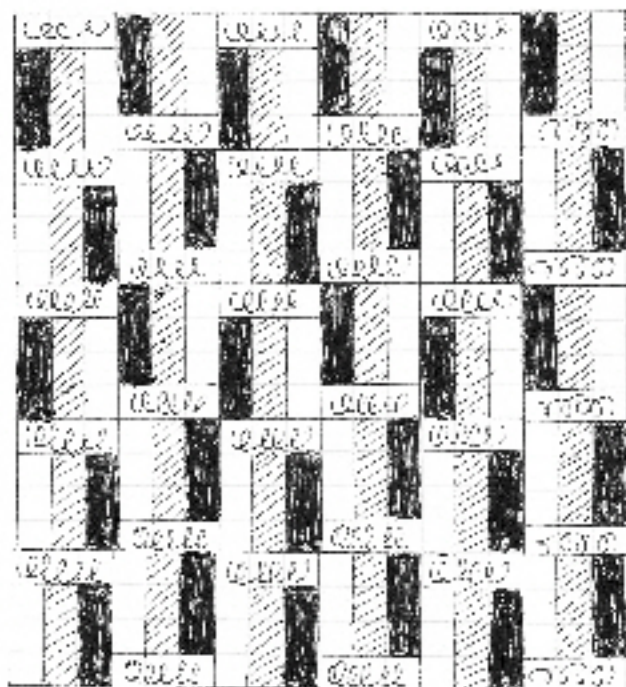


6 x 8 strippy neo quilt

PLEASE CUT TWO OR MORE KITS AT THE SAME TIME.

The Quilt Top (10 Block A, 10 Block B)

Cutting:

You will need 4 coordinating fabrics, OR scraps of 3 coordinating fabrics and one plainer color fabric to coordinate with the scraps. If you are using scraps, separate them into light, medium and dark value fabrics. You will need to cut thirty $2\frac{1}{2} \times 6\frac{1}{2}$ inch rectangles from EACH of the three fabrics or 90 pieces.

From the plainer coordinating fabric, cut $2\frac{1}{2}$ inch strips by width of fabric. Subcut these strips into thirty $2\frac{1}{2} \times 6\frac{1}{2}$ inch rectangles.

Sewing:

Sew 30 blocks using a light, a medium and a dark rectangle (in that order).

Sew a plain color rectangle onto each block made above. Make 15 of Block A and 15 of Block B.

Sew 6 of the completed blocks into a row using the quilt diagram above as a guide to the correct placement and direction of each block. Sew 5 rows being sure that you are using the correct block as you put them together. Sew the 5 rows together and you have completed the top.

BE SURE TO PIN THE YELLOW TAG ONTO THE COMPLETED QUILT BEFORE YOU TURN IT IN.
