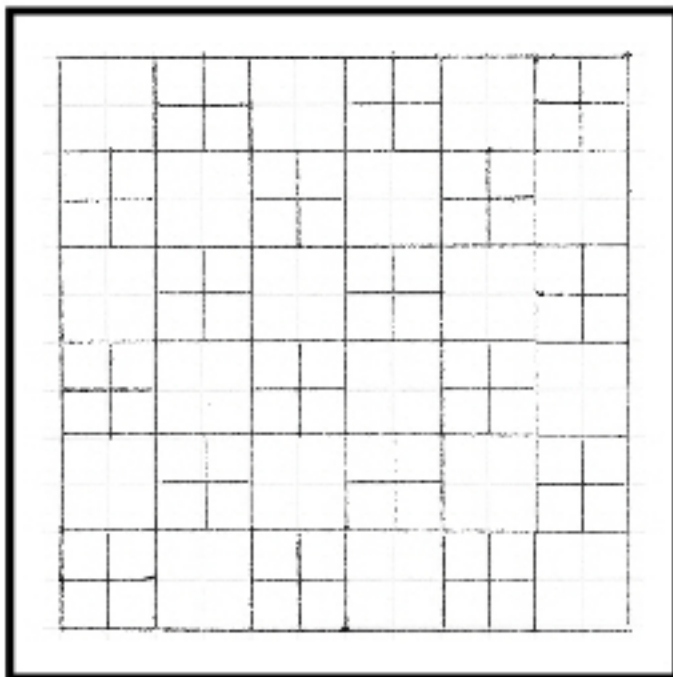


## Alternating Scrappy 4-Patch (6 inch Finished size)



### Cutting Instructions:

Cut 18 four patch 6 1/2 inch squares .

From scraps or fat quarters, cut 3 1/2 inch squares in coordinating colors. You will need a total of 72 squares.

From a coordinating print, cut 4 border strips - two measuring 2 1/2 x 36 1/2 inches and two measuring 2 1/2 x 40 1/2 inches.

### Assembly Instructions:

Sew the 3 1/2 inch squares into 18 four patch blocks. Alternate a 6 1/2 inch block with a four patch block to create 6 rows. Sew the 6 rows together making sure that you follow the layout diagram above.

Attach the borders and you have completed the 40 1/2 inch square top.

Finish in any manner you choose.
